

# Dojo Rules

1. Never wear shoes on the training floor.
2. During class, discussion should be held to a minimum. Questions may be asked by raising your hand and being recognized.
3. Bow anytime you enter or leave the Dojo.
4. Walk along the walls before and after a lesson. Never walk In the middle of a class in session.
5. Your uniform should always be kept neat and clean. The Obi should be worn at all times and properly tied around the waist.
6. Summer uniform may be worn after April 1<sup>st</sup>. (DMA t-shirt, Obi, and Gi pants)
7. Winter uniform must be worn after October 1<sup>st</sup>. (Full Gi and Obi)
8. No loitering or Horse play, students are expected to practice discipline at all times.
9. Never show anger or disgust, these are signs of lack of discipline and self control and can effect your eligibility to advance in rank.
10. Students will not chew gum or have food or drink near the training area.
11. Prior to class, all jewelry should be removed that can cause injury to yourself or others.
12. Never abuse weapons or equipment by throwing them down or placing them or placing them where they may be damaged.
13. Never interrupt an instructor when he is instructing or practicing.
14. Students should contribute to keeping the Dojo clean and in good repair.
